

## EAN Educational Programmes 2019/2020

Dear Colleague,

In 2019/2020, EAN will again grant a diversity of educational grants and programmes for neurologists in training and newly qualified specialists.

### **2019 - EAN Autumn School October 17-20, 2019 in, Loutraki, Greece**

This 4-day annual course offers hands-on lectures and workshops for up to 60 neurologists in training to give them the chance to increase their knowledge of clinical neurology. Participants pay for their travel only.

→ Application deadline: 31 July 2019

### **Research Fellowship 2020**

Up to 8 research experience or training fellowships of 6 – 12 months duration will be awarded, each amounting to € 2.000,- per month.

Research training fellowship:

Typically, 12 months and minimum of 6 months duration, to lead either to completion of a higher degree, a grant application or peer-reviewed publication

Research experience fellowship:

Typically, no more than 6 months duration for individuals who might otherwise not have the opportunity to gain high quality research experience, but who may wish to pursue a research career. Applications from more experienced clinicians/researchers requiring training in a specific research methodology or technique not currently available in their own country and of clear value to home department will also be considered.

→ Application deadline: 31 August 2019

### **Clinical Fellowship 2020**

35 grants to provide a well- defined clinical observational experience in a department with recognised expertise in a specific field. Each grant amounts to a maximum of € 2.250,- to facilitate visits to foreign departments for 6 weeks.

### **EAN Spring School June 2020 in Frankenfels, Austria**
